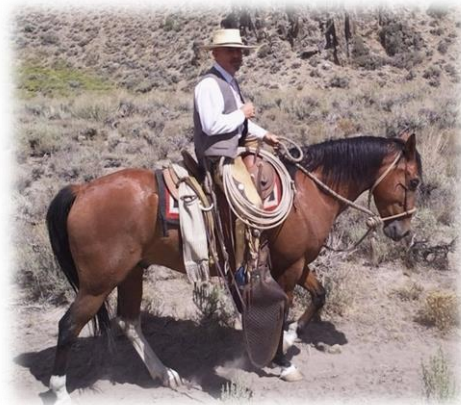

They will show you how to ride your horse with feel, and how, by getting the balance and timing correct, it can enhance the partnership of your horse and open up a world of opportunities that you've only ever dreamed of.

Topics to be covered include, amongst others, are:-
Groundwork, and how it positively effects your riding
Biomechanics of horse and rider, and how the correct lateral work will help to engage your horse to become light
Saddle fit and other gear fit (i.e. hackamore/bridle etc)
Working with the Garrocha to improve your riding skills
Working with cattle to give you and your horse a purpose
Working Equitation/trail course skills

This horsemanship clinic will be suitable for all types of riding disciplines so whether you are a high level competitor or a pleasure rider, do trail riding or Dressage, ride Western or English style everyone will benefit from learning from these 2 Masters of Horsemanship.

Riding places are very limited so don't delay in showing your interest.

Cost for 4 days tuition plus dinner (catered) for 5 nights is \$995

Venue Information:

“Banyandah” is situated on the Murray River and is a mix of open farming land as well as native bush and wetlands. The 400 acres will engage the mind, body and soul as well as be an amazing clinic venue to challenge your horsemanship experiences.

The Light House is the central hub for clinic venue this has been designed as a meeting place, teaching place and accommodation. Close by you will find the Cattleman's Hut, float parking, day yards for 40 horses, 3 sand arenas, plus stables.

The property boasts an amazing playground to challenge your horsemanship skills with bridges, water crossings, stairs, and jumps. There is also another large sand arena - 50 by 70 - where the horsemanship clinic will be conducted, hidden on the river flats amongst the river gums.

The property is located on the Vic and NSW borders- address details are 5527 Riverina Highway, Howlong.

Accommodation

On site accommodation is available but is limited so first in best dressed. The Light House is luxurious and completely self-contained. There are four bedrooms each with two single bunks and two bathrooms. Adjacent to the

beautiful kitchen is a superb lounge area with TV and DVD. BYO linen, or linen can be hired as per below.

The Cattleman's Hut is available if you choose to camp. This has cooking and eating facilities as well as bathroom amenities.

FEED MERCHANT SUPPLIES

The local feed merchant is happy to make a bulk delivery to the venue the day prior to the clinic commencing. Details will be sent nearer to the clinic date.

FOOD

The catered sit down evening meal ensures that you can relax at the end of the day and not have to worry about cooking! Food allergies also catered for with prior arrangement. Breakfast and lunch are BYO.

Supermarkets etc. are located in either Howlong or Corowa 10 mins drive from the venue for any other items required for your stay.

WHAT TO BRING

Riders must supply their own horses and tack
All weather clothing- no indoor arena & we will ride in any conditions
Food for breakfast and lunch (dinner is catered) and feed for your horse.
Chair for spectating.

Please arrive with enough time to settle and park prior to the clinic starting time of 9am.

Yards are to be cleaned prior to leaving.
